The Process for Exporting Live Animals or Products of Animal Origin from Great Britain to the European Union is Changing

The United Kingdom (UK) left the European Union (EU) on 31 January 2020 and is currently in the transition period. On 31 December 2020 the transition period with the EU will end. There will be changes at the border for moving goods between Great Britain (GB) and the EU, which businesses need to prepare for. These changes will happen regardless of the agreement we reach with the EU on our future trade relationship.

As a result, from the 1 January 2021 the process for exporting live animals* and products of animal origin** from GB to the EU is changing.

Exporting from GB to the EU Webinars

To assist you with your preparations for these changes, we have organised a series of webinars throughout October and November that will provide you with key information to enable you to continue to export from GB to the EU.

The webinars have been split into the three key topics to ensure you receive tailored information to meet your specific exporting requirements:

1. The end to end exporting journey
2. Export Health Certificates (EHCs)
3. Marketing standards / health ID marks / labelling

* **Live animals**—includes living animals that exported for the purposes of farming, keep as pets and equines, research and for the purposes of human food consumption and livestock.

** **Products of animal origin**—includes any product that is part of an animal or that have been produced containing extract, partial or whole animals. This will include beef steaks, sausages, ready-made meat lasagnes, milk, chicken kiev, sandwich ham etc. It can also contain products that are not for human consumption i.e. pet food, or fertilisers for farming lands etc.
